

Data Protection

Administration

We will pass your information to our business providers who will process your data on behalf and under our control. Our providers assist us with the administration of your examination and technological support.

We use standard model contract clauses to ensure that the adequacy of personal data transferred internationally meets with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) requirements.

We will use your voice recordings and written responses in connection with processing your Aptis assessment. We may also collect personal information (your name, address, date of birth, a form of identification number and country of residence) for purposes of verifying your identity.

Our lawful basis for processing your personal data for administration purposes is the performance of your test contract. In line with our corporate retention schedule, we will keep your personal data for three years after the date of the test.

Research

The British Council Assessment Group (ARG) will occasionally use voice recordings and written responses to conduct research, review the performance of assessment products or design new assessment products.

These recordings might be used by individuals or organisations working in partnership with us to research the English language and English language assessment. We may record the date and country of origin of these recordings, but will not associate your name, date of birth or any other form of personal identification with these recordings.

Our lawful basis for processing your personal data for research purposes is our legitimate interest. In line with our corporate retention schedule, we may keep these recordings for up to 10 years.

You have the rights to access your personal data, to ask us to correct any inaccuracies or to erase your data or to ask us to stop using your data by contacting us at <u>igdisclosures@britishcouncil.org</u>. If you have concerns about how we have used your personal information, you also have the right to complain to a privacy regulator.
