Use adjectives to describe school subjects.  Identify activities for school subjects.  Understand school timetables	<ol> <li>What is your favourite subject? Draw and write.</li> <li>What activities do you like doing at school? Make a list.</li> <li>Write a new rule for your English class! Tell your classmates.</li> <li>Interview your classmates about their schools.</li> <li>Project: Make a comic strip about a day at school.</li> </ol>	School subjects: Art, Computing, Drama, English, Geography, Maths, Music, PE, Science  Adjectives for subjects: I agree that Music is fun. I think Computing is boring.  Maths is interesting.
3. Go wild  To understand endangered animals	Identify and name wild animals.  Say what animals can and cannot do.  Identify and name parts of animals.  Describe animal habitats.  Understand why wild animals are endangered.	<ol> <li>Draw and write about your favourite animal.</li> <li>Draw a fantastic animal and tell your classmates what it can do.</li> <li>Create a poster for another fantastic new animal at the farm.</li> <li>Create a fact file for an endangered animal. Tell your classmates about it.</li> <li>Project: Make a poster about an endangered animal.</li> </ol>	Wild animals: koala bear, macaw, meerkat, monkey, penguin, tiger  Animal actions: climb, dig, fly, jump, swim, swing  Can and cannot for ability:  Pandas can climb trees.  Meerkats cannot fly.

I go from 4 o'clock to 5 o'clock
5. What do you do?  To understand different jobs  ***********************************	Identify and name jobs/tasks. Identify and describe working days and hours. Understand where people work. Think about what kinds of jobs there are. Describe what jobs involve. Understand how jobs contribute to society.	<ol> <li>Imagine that you do a job for a day. Draw and write.</li> <li>Ask your classmates about their dream jobs.</li> <li>Make a list of tasks that Bitzer does on the farm.</li> <li>Write about a family member's job.</li> <li>Project: Make and present a poster about jobs that you want to try.</li> </ol>	Jobs: chef, dentist, firefighter, scientist, police officer, vet  Job tasks: do experiments, check people's teeth, cook food, keep animals healthy, keep people safe, put out fires  Talk about time: I work Monday to Saturday.  Express dreams: I want to be a vet.  Present simple: I work in a hospital
